

You Can't Trust Mike Rann and Kevin Foley

Kevin Foley's Budget cuts 4,000 jobs and services to the community.

That's bad enough...but it also breaks commitments and promises made to over 100,000 workers.

ON JOB SECURITY

In February 2010, just prior to the state election, Premier Rann signed a letter to the Public Service Association which renewed a promise of "no forced redundancies" for a further 4 years.

A few months after the election, in September 2010, Treasurer Kevin Foley handed down a Budget and declared that all bets were off on forced redundancies. He announced that the no forced redundancy policy would be reconsidered if his job cuts were "not achieved in 12 months".

ON WORKING CONDITIONS

On 14 January 2010 an Enterprise Agreement covering 30,000 public sector workers was certified committing the government to job security and no reduction in "existing conditions of employment"

Similar Agreements have been made with teachers, police, firefighters, nurses, ambulance workers, health professionals, scientists and engineers.

Now they want to pass legislation that cuts existing leave conditions and overrides the Agreements they have signed up to.

Rann and Foley can't be trusted to keep their word or honour their agreements.
